

Automated Document Management Systems *at a glance ...*

What is an Automated Document Management System?

- A system that enables reports and other communication to be instantly and confidentially transferred between various users (e.g., Adjusters, Consultants) via a secure Internet site
- Enables user to proactively manage the file online with all communication, reports and historical data at your fingertips whenever you need it

When Can I Use It?

- To submit referrals
- To review and monitor files/activities
- To write notes
- To ask questions
- To receive and review reports

What Kind of Progress Can I Monitor?

- Receipt of the referral
- Assignment of the file
- Consultant activities
- Notes, questions
- Consultant report
- Historical information

What Are the Advantages of Using It?

- *Instant referral transmission*
- *Immediate Confirmation of Assignment*
- *Secure and confidential communication* (via secure, encrypted Internet site)
- *Historical archives of all documentation at your Fingertips* (no more pulling out huge paper files)
- *Smooth transition* (a new Adjuster has easy access to up-to-date information)
- *Cost savings* (quick response can lead to quicker file closure)
- *Increased efficiency* (no more searching through the mail or tracking down courier packages)
- *Internet use eliminates the need for ongoing investment in systems and hardware*
- *No more "phone tag"* (all communication can be done online)
- *Proactive file management* (monitor Consultant whenever you like)
- *Paperless* (all documentation stored online and easily down loaded when needed)
- *Flexible* (system can be adapted to the specific needs of each user)

How Do I Use It?

- Via a password over a secure Internet site
- The password (secret word or phrase that gives the user access to particular information) ensures that only the intended reader can access the information
