

## **Disability Insurer Examination Preparation**

The next time you need to refer for a Disability IE, use this checklist to ensure you have gathered all of the required documentation and have referred for the most appropriate assessors/assessments.

## **Documentation**

Disability Certificates (OCF 3) - the original and any subsequent	1
Employer confirmation Form (OCF 2) & Job Site Assessment (re: Income	V
Replacement Benefit eligibility)	
Ambulance & Hospital Records (if any)	V

Relevant medical documentation regarding disability including any previous Insurer	1
Examination reports	
Pre-accident clinical notes & records from family physician & any other treating	1
professionals, including physiotherapist, chiropractor, psychologist, etc.	2
In-home Assessment report (re: Caregiver & Non-earner benefit eligibility)	1
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## **Assessors/Assessments**

Physicians specific to the disability, For example:	1
Orthopaedic Physician for fractures	
<ul> <li>Psychologist for emotional issues</li> </ul>	
Neuro-psychologist for brain injury	
Functional Abilities Evaluation – to assess functional status and compare with a Job Site Assessment (re: Income Replacement Benefits eligibility)	1
In-home Assessment – to assess ability to perform activities of daily living	1
(especially important re: Caregiver and Non-earner eligibility)
